PROPHET WARNS PEOPLE TO REFLECT EVIL WAYS

By NEWMAN CAMPBELL, ISAIAH, PROPHET OF GOD, warned his people that they would inevitably follow if they persisted in their evil ways. Isaiah prophesied, probably about the year 740 B. C., thousands of years ago: 'And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide Mine eyes from you; ye pray, when ye make your hands full of blood.' 'Your appointed feasts' refers to the great assemblies at the Jews' annual festivals, such as the Passover, the Feast of Tabernacles, and others. The solemn meetings were the solemnity which concluded these festivities.
