**Frosting, Cake Mixes Make Baking Easier**

**NEW YORK (U.P.)**—Cake and frosting mixes have made the business of baking vastly simpler. "You still have to pour the batter in the pan and turn on the oven," one expert commented, "but these are about the only two steps that haven't changed."

Now a new way has been developed to turn out fancy frostings, fillings and sauces in a few minutes to top these ready-mix cakes. By using the new instant pudding mix as an ingredient, the cake toppings can be made without cooking. Two of the fancy toppings developed are an orange whip filling for spice cake and a mocha cream sauce for a devil's food cake.

**Orange Whip**  
**INGREDIENTS:** 1 1/4 cups orange juice, 1 cup cold milk, 1/2 teaspoon orange rind and 1 package instant vanilla dessert.

**METHOD:** Pour orange juice and milk in large bowl. Add orange rind and instant dessert and whip rapidly with a rotary beater for 30 seconds, or until smooth. Serve with hot gingerbread.

**Mocha Cream Sauce**  
**INGREDIENTS:** 1 cup cold strong coffee, 1 cup cold milk, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 2 teaspoon sugar, 1 package instant vanilla dessert, and 1/4 cup cream.

**METHOD:** Pour coffee and milk into bowl, add salt, sugar, and instant dessert. Whip rapidly with rotary beater 30 seconds, until smooth. Stir in cream. Serve on squares of white cake. Recipe makes 2 1/2 cups of sauce.

For those who prefer to begin their cake baking with sugar and shortening instead of a ready mix, a new recipe for a banana crunch cake will cut down preparation time in at least one way. The cake requires no frosting. A banana topping is spread over the cake batter before it's baked.

**Banana Crunch Cake**  
**INGREDIENTS:** 1 1/2 cups sifted flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup shortening, 1 cup sugar, 2 eggs, separated, 1/4 cup almond extract, 1/2 cup milk, and 1/2 cup chopped nuts.

For the topping: 3 medium bananas, 2 tbsps. brown sugar, 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, and 1 tbsps. butter or margarine.

**METHOD:** Sift together sifted flour, baking powder and salt. Cream together shortening and sugar until light and fluffy. Add egg yolks and almond extract. Mix well. Add flour mixture to creamed mixture alternately with milk. Fold in chopped nuts. Beat egg whites until stiff and fold in. Pour batter into greased pan, 8 inches square.

Then top the batter with bananas, sliced lengthwise. Sprinkle with a mixture of brown sugar, cinnamon and butter and bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 40 minutes.

**Newspaper Insert Reunites Family**

**LUSK, Wyo. (U.P.)**—Eighty-two-year-old Mose Bourgoin of Lusk, who spent 20 years searching for his family, has been reunited with them after 36 years of separation. Bourgoin left his home in Canada 36 years ago to search for work in the United States, and when he finally found it, tried to contact his family. They had moved and he could find no trace of them.

About 20 years ago he began a systematic search which included writing letters to all people in Canada who might know of them, a personal search through Canada, and a five-year hunt by the Canadian Mounted Police.

It was to no avail. Even the Mounties gave up the job.

Continuing his search alone, Bourgoin began inserting small personal ads in Canadian newspapers. Finally a friend of one of his daughters saw a notice and called her, Mrs. Lloyd McFarlane of Wilcox, Saskatchewan.

In turn, she called another daughter, Mrs. W. C. Metzger of Minneapolis, Minn., and they called Bourgoin. They came to Lusk to visit their father.

Bourgoin found he still has a brother and 91-year-old sister living in Canada. Besides the two daughters who visited him, he has three sons in Canada whom he expects to visit.
