Sunday School Lesson

Disciples Carry on Jesus' Work

POWER GIVEN THEM THROUGH HOLY GHOST

Scripture—Acts 1: 1-1 Peter 2:9-10.

WITH THIS FIRST LESSON of the year 1950, we have the Prophecies of the great prophets of Israel, and begin a study of the early days of the new church, and the work of the disciples, in carrying out Jesus' instructions, given them before His ascension.

after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

"And when He had spoken these things, while they beheld, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight." The disciples gazed steadfastly toward heaven, watching the Lord's ascension, and two persons in white (angels, undoubtedly) stood by them.

MEMORY VERSE

"But ye shall receive power, when the Holy Spirit is come upon you, and ye shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea and Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."—Acts 1:8.

one highly educated man among the disciples. He was a Gentile and contemporary with Paul—not one of those who associated with the Master while He was on earth.

The gospel begins with the story of Christ's ascension, which occurred 40 days after His resurrection. He had appeared to His disciples many times during this period, and in this last day He instructed them in the carrying on of the work in His absence.

Jesus and the disciples were on the Mount of Olives, outside Jerusalem. He told them they should stay on in Jerusalem until they had been baptized by the Holy Ghost, which, He promised, would be "not many days hence."

Peter then made a speech, suggesting that they must choose a man to take the place of Judas Iscariot, so they would be 12 when they began their ministry after power had been given them. They appointed two men, "Joseph called Barnabas, who was surnamed Justus, and Matthias."

They prayed for guidance, then drew lots, and the choice fell to Matthias, so he became the twelfth member of the apostles. It is interesting to note how the day of Pentecost changed these men. From looking for the re-establishment of their old kingdom of Israel on earth, they turned to the business of founding the church of Jesus Christ, which was to extend to a great part of the earth—and which is for Gentiles as well as Jews.

List Your Property Give In Your Poll IN JANUARY

All property owners and taxpayers in Haywood County are required to return returns for Taxation for the year 1950 all the Real Estate, Personal Property, and each shall own on the First day of January.

All male persons between the ages of 21 and 50 are required to list their property the same time.

All persons who own property and fail to list it and all who are liable to pay fail to give themselves in will be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor \$2.00 PENALTY WILL BE CHARGED FOR FAILURE TO LIST
