**Einstein Finds His Paradise**



NEW YORK — Albert Einstein found his paradise just to study the life of a simple housewife.

The great scientist writes about it in a rare chapter of autobiographical notes in a new book, "Albert Einstein: Philosopher-Scientist," the first volume in the Library of Living Philosophers.

Einstein wrote the autobiographical notes in the winter of 1916-17, in Göttingen, a town in Germany.

"Here I sit in order to write, at the age of 47, something like my own autobiography," he begins. "It is now 7:00."

It is not the usual recording of dates, places, people, and events, though Einstein tells how his thinking developed, leading to his famous theory of relativity.

Dr. Einstein says "the essential in the biography of a man of my type lies not in WHAT he thinks and DOES, but in what he BECOMES."

Dr. Einstein's part of his philosophy, he says, "is that when I was a child I was not a man, but a boy, and the boyhood of the human mind is the most wonderful time of his life."

"Moreover, I soon discovered the cruelty of that chase, which in those years was much more carefully covered up by hypocrisy and flattery than in the case today. By the mere existence of his stomach, everyone was obliged to participate in that chase."

"I was not yet 10 years old to attend the school, but I was far from being a child and feeling happy."

"The first day out, there was a storm which I thought of as a punishment for my disobedience. This I have always remembered. That I was the only child of my father's parents, in a family of 12, which has been a source of grief to me ever since."

"The usual tradition of popular science books is that I can remember the exact date of the birth of the universe. The consequence of this is that I am able to give you the exact date of the birth of the universe, which is, of course, the date of the birth of the universe."

"Such was a kind of every kind of authority present in the experience of the child, and towards the beginning, which were all in a scientific social environment, an attitude which has never left me, even though later on, because of a better insight into the casual connections, it lost some of its original poignancy."

"It is quite clear to me that the religious paradise of youth which was thus lost, was a first attempt to free myself from the chains of the 'merely personal,' from an existence which is dominated by wishes, hopes and primitive feelings."

"Out yonder there was the true world, which exists independently of us human beings and which stands before us like a great eternal riddle at least partially accessible to our inspection and thinking."

"The contemplation of this world beckoned like a liberation, and I soon noticed that many a man whom I had learned to esteem and to admire had found in her freedom and security an devoted occupation with it the mental grasp of this extra-personal world within the frame of the given possibilities swam as the highest aim half consciously and half unconsciously before my mind's eye."

"Similarly motivated men of the present and of the past as well as the insects which they had achieved were the friends which could not be lost. The road to this paradise was as arduous and alluring as the road to the religious paradise but it has proved itself fruitful and I have never regretted having chosen it."

The book is edited by Dr. Paul Arthur Schilpp, of Northwestern University, Chicago, Ill. Twenty-five international prominent scientists and philosophers contributed chapters.
