Redwine Named To Communications Post At University Of N. C.

(Special Correspondence) **RALEIGH**—Robert W. Redwine, Raleigh advertising agency executive, has been named by Gov. W. Kerr Scott as administrative assistant of the new N. C. Communication Study Commission and will begin work, with offices in Chapel Hill, in February. Earl Wynn of Chapel Hill, director of the Communication Center at the University, is executive director of the Commission, but will continue with his duties at the University. With most schools now equipped with motion picture and radio apparatus for visual education and special studies, the work of the Communications Commission, and reports from it, will be tied to plans for broadening North Carolina's educational system. Additional personnel will be employed to assist the Commission with its study. A report will be made to the 1951 and 1953 Legislatures.

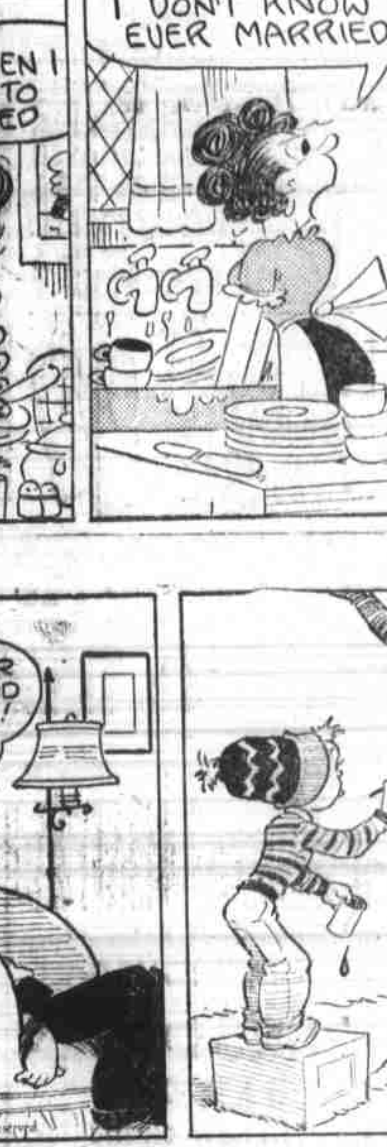

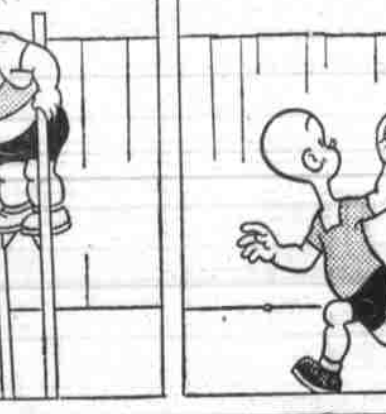

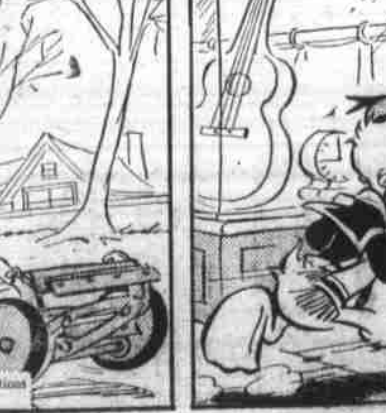
