Reservoir Interior Being Repaired

The Cement Gun Company of Allentown, Pa., is repairing and re-waterproofing the interior of the town reservoir.

Town Manager Grayden Ferguson said this final phase of the overhauling of the plant will be finished in three weeks.

The Pennsylvania firm, inventor of a "gun" which applies concrete under pressure, was awarded the contract on its bid of \$4,776.

The walls and bottom of the reservoir are receiving a two-inch lining and being reinforced with mesh steel.

The inside also is being cleaned by sand blasting.

Earlier this fall, another firm repaired the outside walls of the reservoir.

The complete overhauling, technicians have told town officials, will make the reservoir good for another 30 to 40 years.

Thanksgiving Curtain Call



MINCEMEAT CHEESE CAKE... Thanksgiving Dessert.

Let mincemeat star on your Thanksgiving table in a delicious new dessert. This recipe has everything — because the mincemeat teams up with another favorite, cheese cake. It's a wonderful dessert if you're having holiday company because it's so rich and tasty. The mincemeat used in it is the "dry" or condensed kind that is distinctly American; it was first made in this country in the 1890's and it's been a fine ready-to-use product ever since. You'll be interested to know that the basic ingredients of a nine-ounce package of mincemeat are: Fresh apples, two kinds of raisins, currants, orange and lemon rind, brown sugar, distilled white vinegar, choice cider, salt, a small amount of beef, choice spices.

MINCEMEAT CHEESE CAKE (REFRIGERATOR-STYLE)

Ingredients: 1 nine-ounce package mincemeat, 1 cup water, zwiebach crumb mixture (see recipe below) 1 cup cold water, 2 tablespoons (2 envelopes) unflavored gelatin, 2 eggs (separated), 3/4 cup sugar, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 4 three-ounce packages cream cheese (at room temperature), 1 teaspoon lemon rind, 2 tablespoons lemon juice, 1/2 cup chilled evaporated milk (whipped) or 3/4 cup heavy cream (whipped).

Method: Break mincemeat into pieces in small saucepan. Add 1 cup water. Place over medium heat and stir until lumps are thoroughly broken. Boil briskly 2 minutes. Cool. Press zwiebach crumb mixture on sides and bottom of 8" spring form pan, saving 1/4 cup crumbs for top. Put 1/2 cup cold water in mixing bowl and sprinkle with gelatin. Put egg yolks in top of double boiler and beat slightly; mix in well remaining 1/2 cup cold water; add sugar and salt and mix well. Cook over simmering water until mixture thickens slightly, about 5 minutes. Pour over softened gelatin, stirring until dissolved. Cool. Cream the cheese until fluffy. Slowly mix in gelatin mixture. Thoroughly blend in lemon rind and juice. Chill until mixture thickens slightly. Mix cooled mincemeat into gelatin mixture. Fold in whipped evaporated milk or heavy cream. Then fold in egg whites which have been stiffly beaten. Pour into crumb lined pan. Sprinkle remaining crumbs on top. Chill in refrigerator until firm, about 2 to 3 hours.

ZWIEBACH CRUMB MIXTURE

Ingredients: 1 1/4 cup firmly packed zwiebach crumbs (about 15 zwiebach); 1/4 cup sugar, 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, 1/4 cup butter (melted).

Method: Mix zwiebach crumbs, sugar, and cinnamon. Stir in butter; blend well.
