Farm Price Controls, Burley To Be Discussed

Will H. Rogers, Greensboro, Director of Organization, N. C. F. B., said today that price controls, the burley tobacco program, and farm insurance rates would be among the numerous topics to be discussed during the Haywood County Farm Bureau meeting which will be held at the Court House, May 21, at 8:00 P. M.

"The issues on price controls," Rogers said, "will be clearly drawn within the next thirty days. When Congress rewrites the defense act, they will consider the farmers this time."

He pointed out that the Farm Bureau has finally won the fight which began two years ago over insurance rates on farm homes. "These rates," he said, "were \$1.14 per hundred on farm homes, but now, they are down to 52 cents."

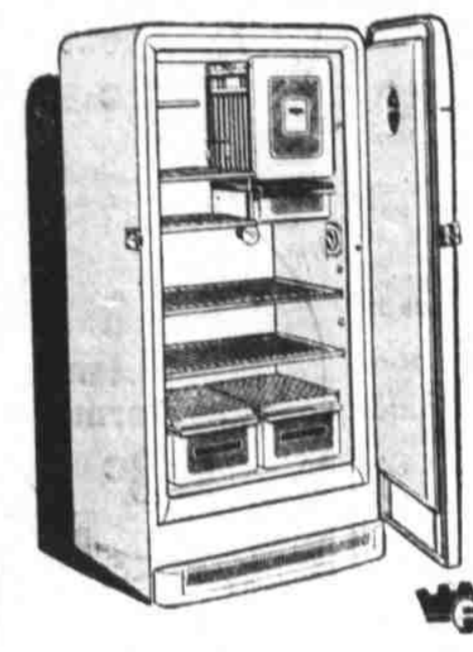
