The State Highway Commission completed an .07-mile surfacing project in Haywood County under the \$200,000,000 bond issue program during May.  
Grading and surfacing with traffic bound macadam were finished on the Smith Road.  
The Commission has finished one-half of Governor Scott's requested 12,000-mile paving goal under the secondary bond issue program. Some 6,000 miles of farm-to-market roads have been hard-surfaced and another 9,825 miles stabilized for all-weather travel during the last two years.
