Noted Tenor Appearing At Lake Tuesday Night

A nationally known lyric tenor soloist, Frank Mellor, will be presented at 8 p. m. Wednesday at the Lake Junaluska Methodist Assembly auditorium in a program of sacred and concert music.

Mr. Mellor, who seeks to bring to American audiences an appreciation of the better things in music, is a resident of St. Petersburg, Fla. when not on tour. Walter Damrosch has acclaimed him as "the possessor of a phenomenally beautiful voice." Cyrus Daniel, the assembly's director of music, will serve Mr. Mellor as accompanist.

The Rev. Murdo Ewen MacDonald of Edinburgh, Scotland, was the platform speaker this morning in the first of a series of five sermons. An eminent Presbyterian clergyman, he will preach at 8 p. m. tonight and Tuesday, and at 11 a. m. tomorrow and Wednesday.

A nine-day South-wide School of Missions will open Wednesday at the lake. Sponsored by the southern jurisdiction of the Methodist Woman's Society of Christian Service, the school will be attended by 250 delegates of eight states. Business sessions will be held at Lambuth Inn, and general meetings at the auditorium in order that Lake Junaluska and Waynesville area residents may hear the platform speakers.

Mrs. E. U. Robinson of Franklin, Tenn., southeastern WSCS president, will address the group at 8 p. m. Thursday. Her subject will be "Lift High the Cross of Christ." She has called a meeting of society's executive committee at 9:30 a. m. tomorrow.

Bill Thalheimer — Eugene Kirsch

A noted theologian of Vanderbilt University, Dr. Nels F. S. Ferre, will give the general lectures in five platform appearances, July 15-18, speaking on the theme, "Christianity Today". A native of Sweden, he came to this country when he was 13, and became an ordained minister of the Congregational Church in 1934.

Two other widely known theologians will be among the school's faculty of 24 members. Dr. Leslie Sayre, an editor and departmental director of the National Council of Churches, New York, will teach a course in "Churches for our Country's Needs". Dr. Charles M. Laymon, formerly dean of Scarritt College, Nashville, Tenn., will teach a Bible course centered on the Book of Acts. In January Dr. Laymon became pastor of Indianola Methodist Church on the campus of Ohio State University, Columbus, Ohio.

The Jurisdictional Wesleyan Service Guild will hold a special program July 13-15 in conjunction with the school. The chief speaker will be Miss Elizabeth Lee of New York, who is executive secretary for Latin America of the Methodist Woman's Division of Christian Service. Her subject will be "Our Faith Tremendous for This Hour".

Save Flashlight Batteries
