County Health Board To Issue Food Permits, Make Milk Survey

The County Health Board today issued three announcements of interest to milk producers, restaurant owners and food handlers.

On July 16 there will be a Federal Government survey of the milk shed. Grading will be done on a Federal form.

Anyone buying a restaurant or other eating place must have a Health Board permit for alterations or repairs, or for installation of septic tanks or a water supply.

All food handlers must have a Health examination, including a chest X-ray.

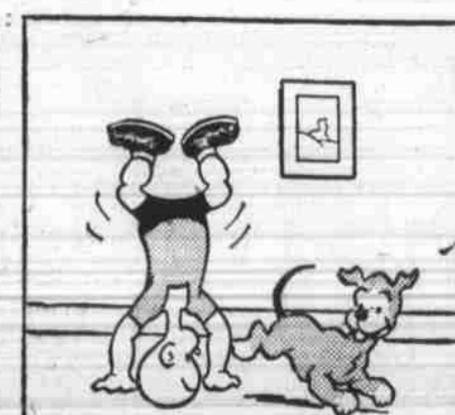

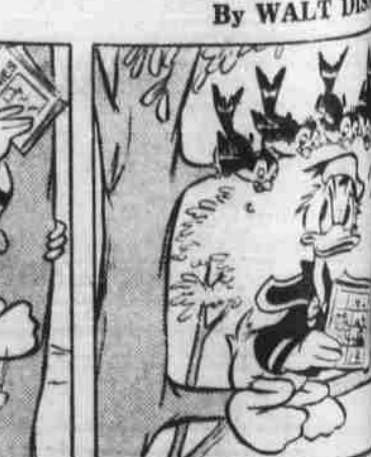
