Her son John, tional AAU team title last fall, has wrote on "Why My Husband mended by the United States Public Health Service, adopted by resolution of the Haywood County Board of Health May 12, 1950, it shall be the duty of the local Health Department at least once every six months to announce the grades of all milk and milk products delivered by all producers or distributors and ultimately consumed within the county of Haywood or its police jurisdiction, Said grades shall be based upon the following standards: Grade A Raw Milk, to be consumed raw, the average bacterial plate count which does not exceed 50,000 per cc.! Grade A Pasteurized milk 30,000. In the case of cream, bacterial standards shall be doubled and omitted in the case of sour cream adn buttermilk Vitamin D milk shall be only of Grade A Pasteurized or of certified Grade A Raw quality

"Section 3 of the Standard Milk Ordinance states: it shall be unlawful for any person to bring into or receive into the County of Havwood or its police jurisdiction for sale or to sell or offer for sale therein, or to have in storage where milk and milk products are sold or served, any milk or milk products defined in this ordinance, who does not possess a permit from the Health Department of Haywood County. Only a person who complies with the requirements of the Ordinance shall be entitled to receive and retain such a permit,

"Immediately following the announcement of grades, the Health Department shall see to it that the Grades are displayed in each restaurant, soda fountain, etc., where milk is being served or distributed to the public.

"The following firms have a permit to sell Grade A Pasteurized Milk and Milk Products: Biltmore Dairies of Asheville; Burgin's Dairy of Dellwood; Pet Dairy of Waynesville; Skybrook of Hendersonville; Southern Dairies of Asheville, "The following firms have per-

mits to sell Grade A Raw Milk: Ferguson's of Dellwood,

"Notice is hereby given to all restaurants, grocery stores, meat markets, etc., selling or serving ungraded or uncertified milk or milk products: raw milk, country butter, buttermilk or any other milk products will not be tolerated in Havwood County as the Standard Milk Ordinance prohibits this.
