Leaders Plan Agricultural Review

Haywood County agricultural leaders met August 16, to make plans for a county-wide review of all agricultural programs in the county administered by the U. S. Department of Agriculture.

Those at the meeting, called by A. W. Ferguson, Chairman of the Agricultural Mobilization Committee, said the study will find out how well the Department programs are serving farm families. The answer to this question will be obtained in community meetings to which all farmers will be invited.

Members of the Haywood County Agricultural Mobilization Committee, business leaders, representatives of farm organizations, and agricultural leaders were at the meeting. At least one more county meeting and a series of community meetings are to be scheduled.

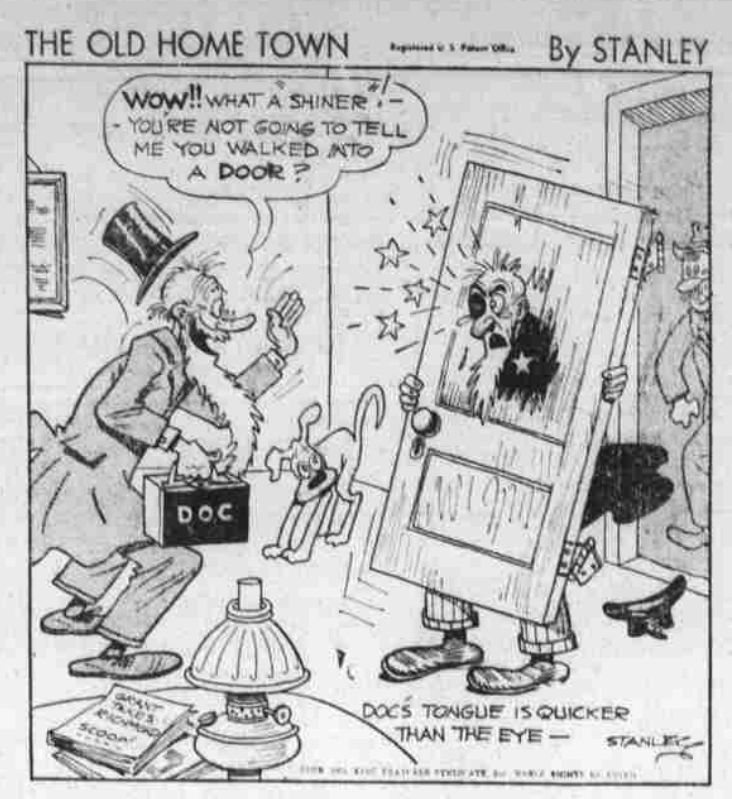
Request for the review was received by G. T. Scott, Chairman of the State Agricultural Mobilization Committee, from Charles F. Brannan, Secretary of Agriculture

and Chairman of the National Agricultural Mobilization Committee. Each county in North Carolina and the nation is to conduct a similar study.

Mr. Ferguson said farmers, businessmen, civic leaders, agricultural workers, preachers, teachers, and others will be asked to study and make recommendations on all agricultural programs.

"The basic idea is to get the thinking of everyone in the county interested in agriculture about how our farm programs and policies can be improved in regard to service to the family farms," said Mr. Ferguson.

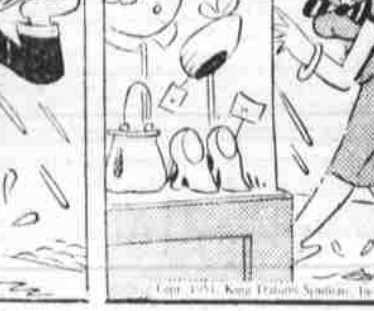

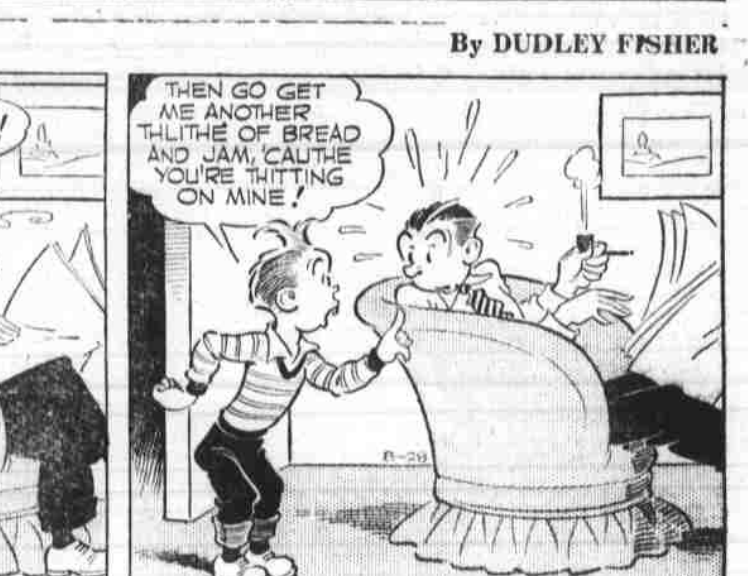

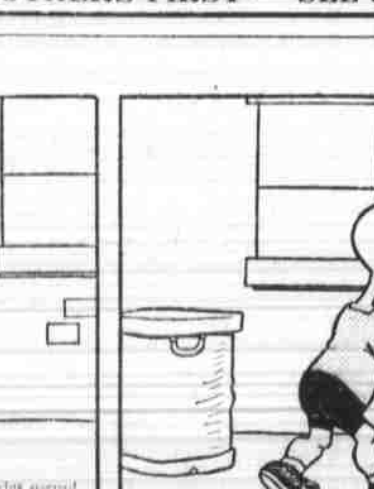
