registered protest, but the state would not approve anything except a consolidation of these two schools with the Bethel unit.

The matter of consolidating the Fines Creek high school with Crabtree-Iron Duff was left optional at such time as the enrollment of the Fines Creek High school fell below 60 students.

The report as handed to the county board of commissioners was a supplementary report of Lindsey Madison Gudger, architect. Mrs. Jones said the identical report was

adopted by the county board on August 22, although their name does not appear on the report.

The proposals of expansion in the Canton school district is not included in the report. A. J. Hutchins, Canton superintendent, sometime ago listed the projects of that district, include a junior high school, and a general expansion of most of the schools that have not been expanded within the past few years. The Canton share of the two million is slightly more than \$600,000.

The breakdown of the proposed projects, as set out in the report of Mr. Gudger is as follows:

UNIT 1: The Bethel Elementary Building, Classes 1 through 8.

- (a) 10 Primary Class Rooms.
 - (b) 20 Graded School Class Rooms.
 - (c) Cafeteria and Kitchen—to serve 500.
 - (d) Library.
 - (e) Teachers' Rest Room.
 - (f) Clinic or First Aid Room.
 - (g) Offices for Principal, etc.
 - (h) Physical Education—full playing court plus lockers.
- Note: This would restore the 10 Primary Class Rooms as originally included but eliminated in the Supplementary Report (this being a recommendation of the Survey Panel). Thus the building would be as originally contemplated.

UNIT 2: Addition to Crabtree School Building, Consolidated School.

- (a) Physical Education—full high school playing court.
 - (b) Agricultural Shops.
 - (c) Music or Band Room.
 - (d) 2 Standard Class Rooms.
- Note: This would restore the building to the approximate originally contemplated project. (Recommended by the Survey Panel for the inclusion of Fines Creek School in the Crabtree facilities, in case the enrollment of the Fines Creek School fell below 60, in which case the State would move the school to Crabtree. The County Board of Education does not recommend the moving of the Fines Creek School due to its geographic location.)

UNIT 3: Waynesville High School C. R. and Adjunct Building.

- (a) Physical Education Building—full high school playing court and lockers, showers, etc.
- (b) 4 Class Rooms for Commerce, etc.
- (c) Cafeteria and Kitchen—to seat 500.
- (d) Home Economics Department.

(e) Shop.
(f) Science Rooms: Approximately 900 sq. ft. for Biology; 900-1000 sq. ft. for Chemistry-Physics, 900 sq. ft. for General Science, and 250 sq. ft. of storage between Biology and General Science.

Note: This revises the Science requirements in accordance with recommendations of the State Board of Education and decreases the seating capacity of the Cafeteria from 1000 to 500.

UNIT 4: School Building for Dellwood.

Note: As covered in the Supplementary Report, this project would be eliminated. However, as verbally recommended by the Survey Panel, the facilities of the schools originally intended to be consolidated in this project would be added, renovated and made adequate by means of the funds set up in Unit 7 (See Below).

UNIT 5: Waynesville Elementary Building, Classes 1 through 6.

- (a) 8 Primary Class Rooms.
- (b) 8 Graded School Class Rooms.
- (c) Auditorium and Stage—to seat 650.
- (d) Cafeteria and Kitchen—to accommodate 325.

Note: This would provide the building as contemplated in the Supplementary Report with the Physical Education facilities eliminated. It would eliminate from the original report, the Physical Education facilities and 16 Class Rooms.

UNIT 6: Clyde Physical Education—High School.

- (a) Physical Education Building—full high school court with lockers.

Note: This does not change the project from the original nor the

St. John's School Opens 13th Year Here On Sept. 4th

Scholarship examinations for entrance into St. John's Parochial School of Waynesville will be given next Thursday from 10 a.m. until noon for those who care to make use of the Haywood Scholarship Fund.

The school will begin its 13th year on Sept. 4th. Although a Catholic school under the direction of the Sisters of St. Francis from Milwaukee, the majority of students are non-Catholics from Waynesville, Canton and Cherokee.

As in the past, classes will be held for kindergarten, grammar, and high school, and tuition will remain the same. The monthly charge is ten dollars for the first child, and one dollar for each additional child in the same family.

The high school faculty has been rearranged. Father Martin Hernady, S.T.L., will teach Religion and Supplementary Report.

UNIT 7: Repairs, Renovations and Additions.

(a) The funds set up for this Unit would seem adequate to care for the required additions to allow for the elimination of the originally contemplated Dellwood Building. Note that the funds contain \$25,000.00 allocated from County Funds. This Unit would be the "buffer" unit in which "over-runs" or "under-runs" in the remaining program would be adjusted. Also the "contingency" fund, not actually used, would be absorbed in this Unit.
