

# Highway Amendment Sets Misdemeanor For Putting Signs On Right-Of-Ways

G. Page, division engineer, announced today the changes in general ordinances of the Highway Commission, which dates the placing of signs on highways of the state.

Section 12. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place any advertising sign, except regulation and warning signs approved by the State Highway and Public Commission, on any high-

way or the right of way thereof, or to permit the erection or placing of any advertising or other sign, as herein prohibited, on any highway or highway right of way which is situated over any land owned, rented, leased or claimed by such person, firm or corporation. From and after the date of the passage of this Section, as rewritten, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation that has erected or placed, or permitted to be erected or placed, any advertising or other sign, as herein prohibited, or for any person, firm or corporation owning, renting, leasing or claiming any land over which a highway or highway

"Be it further ordained that any violation of the provisions of the above ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and be punishable as provided by law for such offense."
