Former Haywood Man Killed In Burke Accident

A former Haywood county citizen was crushed to death Saturday, near Morganton, when a load of pulp wood fell on him. The account of the accident is taken from The Morganton News-Herald, as follows:

A 42-year-old pulpwood cutter died of injuries in Grace Hospital Saturday morning a short time after he was crushed by practically an entire crane-load of pulpwood.

Estes Rathborne of Route 2, Granite Falls, was ducking beneath a load of pulpwood suspended from a heavy loading crane beside a railroad flat car near Table Rock Furniture Company when a steel

cable broke, according to the crane operator, Nathan Dockery, 49, of Andrews.

Dockery said practically the entire load fell on Rathborne, Dockery, Henry White of Andrews, another pulpwood worker, and Charlie Whisnant, who lives a short distance from where the pulpwood was being loaded, all removed heavy logs from the unconscious Rathborne. The injured man never regained consciousness, they said.

Rathborne was working for Cliff Dockery of Andrews, a brother of the crane operator. The accident happened about 11 o'clock Saturday morning, Rathborne was attempting to guide the heavy load of logs onto a flat car and when he ducked beneath the load to help guide it from the other side a steel cable holding one side of the load broke, the crane operator ex-

plained later Saturday morning to Coroner R. F. Setzer.

Setzer later ordered an autopsy and findings showed Rathborne died from multiple crushing injuries of the right chest with rupture of the lungs and liver.

Rathborne had been working for Dockery about three years. He lived in a pulpwood camp just across Castle Bridge in Caldwell County where more than a dozen families of pulpwood workers live.

The dead man was born in Haywood County January 5, 1912, a son of Mrs. Dovie McDonald Rathborne, and the late Sam Rathborne. He was married to the former Thelma Pendergast.

Survivors include his mother, his wife, two sons, James and Vinson, and three daughters, Mary, Marjorie and Martha; and four brothers, Calvin of Waynesville, Rastus and Taylor, both of South Carolina, and Edgar of Waynesville.
