Rory Calhoun Thrills Fans In 'Tomahawk'

The most important ingredients in a Western movie are action and adventure. So, when you add an off-beat story with many twists and no little surprise for an Indian-white man saga, you've got what it takes. And that's what makes "The Yellow Tomahawk," the United Artists release starring Rory Calhoun and Peggie Castle a fine movie of the great days when the American west was torn between peace with the various Indian tribes or perpetual local wars.

The story concerns itself with the breaking of a peace-pact between certain of the Cheyennes through treachery on both sides. Rory Calhoun, Indian scout with a deep knowledge of the strong and rough Wyoming country which he rides, keeps a hilltop rendezvous with a young Cheyenne, "Fire Chief" and learns of a plan of the Cheyennes to resume war against the whites because of the slaughter of members of their tribe by the Major in command of U. S. Cavalry forces encamped at Sand Creek. "Fire Chief" gives Calhoun a war hatchet, its blade daubed in yellow paint which is to be given to the Major as warning. From there on the action and adventure comes thick and fast with an interesting complication which brings Peggie Castle into the thick of the story.

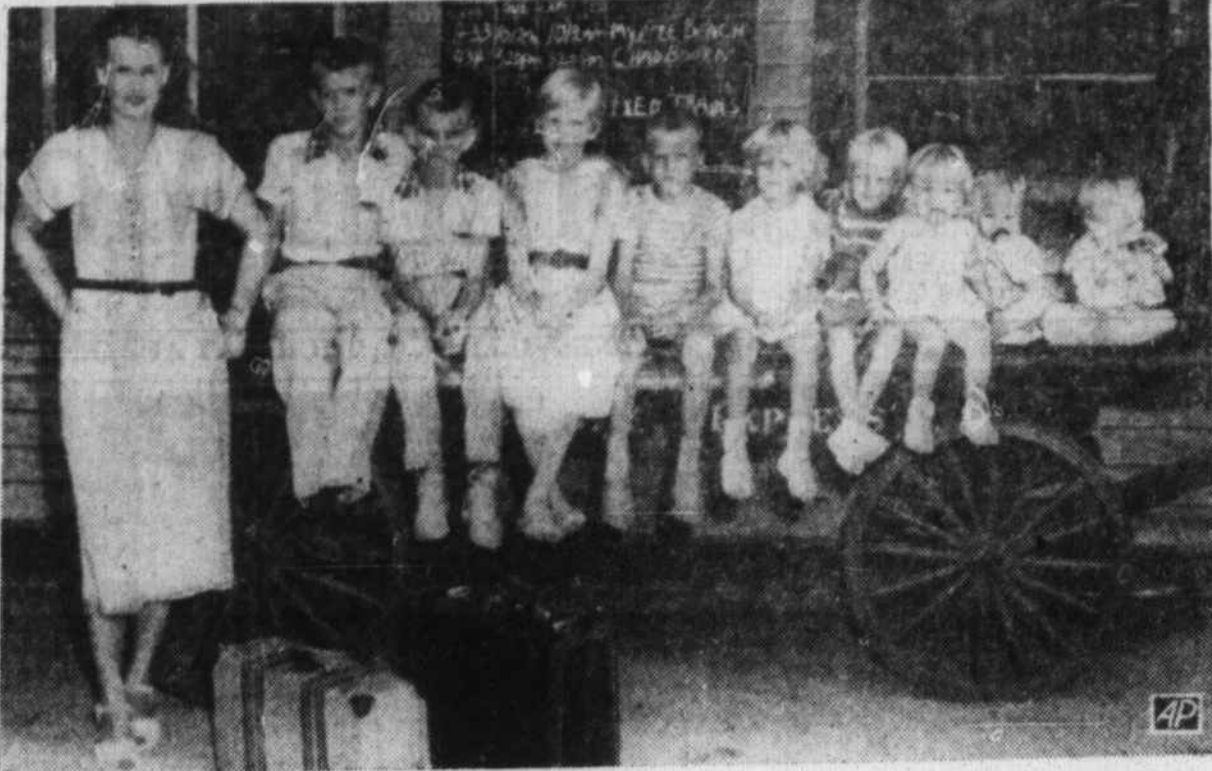

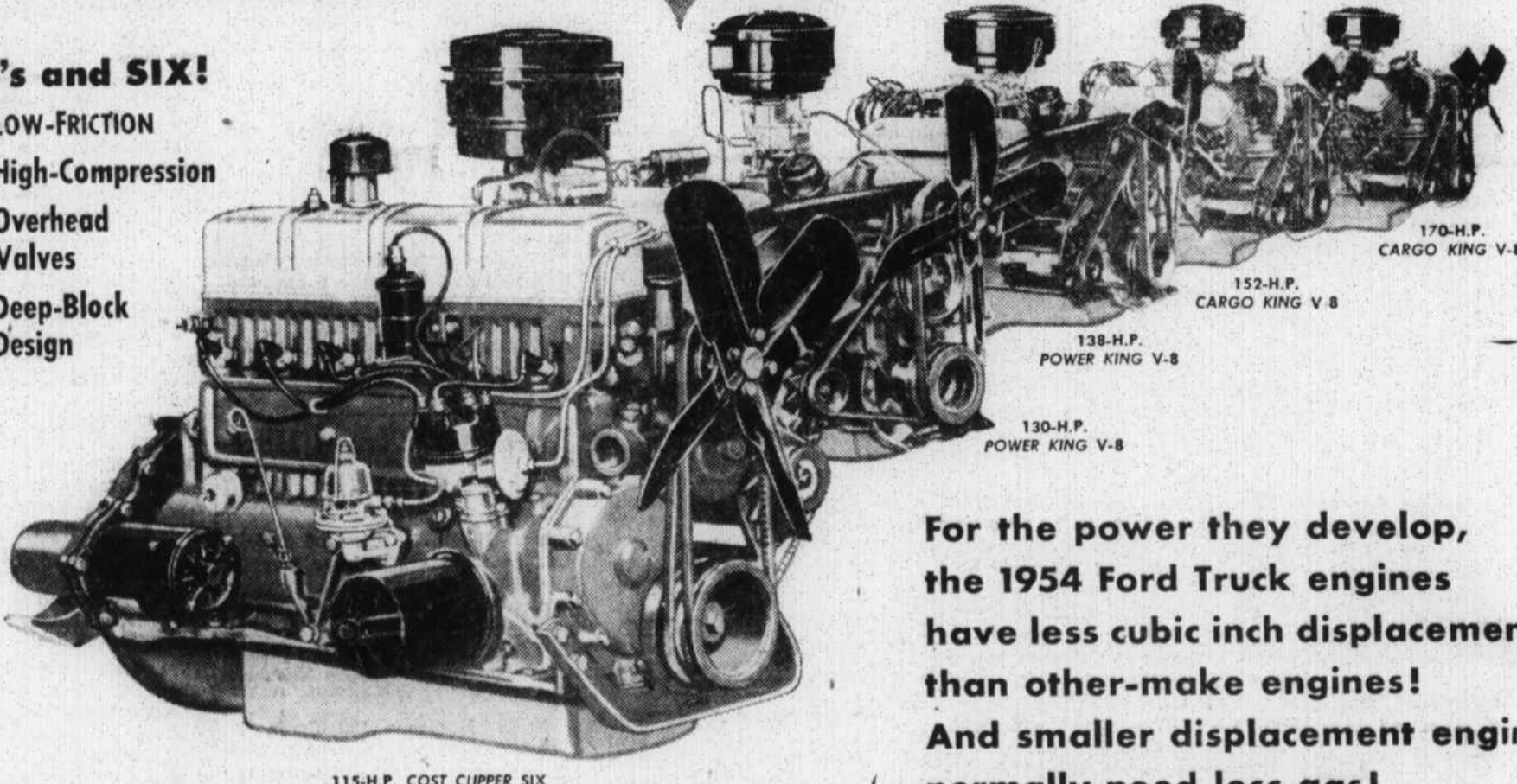
