Heady Autumn Air Whets Appetite For Out-Of-Doors

As approaching autumn brings a hard-cider tang to the morning air, even the not-so-energetic are apt to dream of picnics involving a brisk hike topped by sizzling — if slightly scorched — hamburgers or hot dogs.

Within easy reach of Waynesville lie numerous public recreation areas, complete with water supply and rustic fireplace. Because of the ever present danger of forest fire, lighting of fires in national parks and forests is allowed only in the designated areas, except by special permit.

Besides the developed areas, there are countless spots, deep in the woods or high on a sunny rock, to beckon the adventurer who packs a sandwich and a hard-boiled egg and a thermos of water and starts out.

There are three campgrounds on the North Carolina side of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. They are the Balsam Mountain site on Heintooga Ridge, Smokemont beyond Cherokee and, just opened this summer, the Deep Creek Campground near Bryson City.

Heading from Waynesville to Pisgah National Forest the picnicer finds a round half-dozen developed areas. First is the aptly named Frying Pan Gap, atop Pisgah Ridge, where not only picnic but camping facilities are available. On U. S. 276 on the far slope of Pisgah are Pink Beds, White Pine and Davidson River areas. Other popular sites are Bent Creek, Powhatan and Stony Fork.

Hikers will enjoy the 360-degree view obtainable from the top of Mt. Pisgah, reached by a 1 1/4-mile climb from the Pisgah Parking

Nantahala Region Easy To Reach

The extreme western tip of North Carolina embraced by the Nantahala National Forest is exceptionally attractive throughout the year. Mountain peaks rising more than 5,000 feet above sea level, swift mountain streams broken by cascades and waterfalls and wide unbroken stretches of timberland offer a change in scene at every bend in the road or trail.

Main highways cover the area with service roads leading from these to trails leading to the more remote sections where facilities for

Area. An even stiffer climb is that to the top of Lookingglass Rock, a 3-mile trail starting from N. C. 284, a tangent of U. S. 276.

Two easy-walking and comparatively level hikes following the top of Pisgah Ridge branch off at Beech Gap. The road which ends at the gap follows the West Fork of the Pigeon River from Bethel past Lake Logan. At the gap it is possible to walk along the grade of the Blue Ridge Parkway for several miles, construction machinery permitting. About a mile from Beech Gap is a dramatic overlook up to the Devil's Court House. In the opposite direction a trail follows what will eventually become the Parkway, toward Tennessee Bald and 10 miles across to Richland Balsam, 6540 feet above sea level.

Olden Handicrafts Are Kept Alive In N. C. Highlands

The mountains of Western North Carolina are a treasure house for visitors interested in native handicrafts.

In shops and homes along the busy highways, and in cabins nestled deep in mountain coves, nimble fingers of hundreds of craftsmen ply arts they learned in childhood, fashion a variety of articles which find ready markets.

Travelers have little difficulty in finding places where they may see handicrafts produced and where they may make purchases. Numerous gift shops and handicraft centers, which welcome visitors who want to watch the native artisans at work, are in operation at resort communities and along or near major highways.

Several schools and some of the centers offer courses of instruction for those interested in trying their hand at various crafts.

Quality and production of North Carolina handicrafts have grown steadily within the past generation through the efforts of schools and other organizations which became concerned that the native skills of pioneer days might be dying out.
