My Favorite Stories

This is a story Judge Henry Grady tells that has always appealed to me. It happened when he was a small boy living on a farm down in Sampson County. It was a big farm and his father had several Negroes working for him. Among them was an old man by the name of Mitch. Mitch was quite a character. Nothing ever fazed him in the slightest degree. Nothing ever occurred that caused him to become agitated or excited. He took life as he found it and was willing for everybody else to take it the same way. He never was surprised at anything. They were having one of those old-time county fairs at Clinton, which is the county seat of Sampson. People always looked forward with keen anticipation to these events, and they really were most enjoyable, as you know if you ever attended one. Everybody attended from many miles around. They arrived early in the morning and stayed all day. There were plenty of agricultural and livestock exhibits and there also were the usual number of shows and concessions. But the feature attraction of the fair was the balloon ascension. In order to hold the crowd at the fairgrounds, this event usually did not take place until late in the afternoon. At that time a fire would be started in a large cleared space and the huge bag would be held over it. The smoke would get inside the bag and gradually inflate it. When the proper pressure had been obtained, the balloonist would get into his little basket, the men who were holding the rope would turn it loose, and the balloon would sail upward in majestic fashion while everybody cheered and gaped. It was terribly exciting. On this particular day, all of this procedure was duly carried out. The balloonist climbed in, gave the signal, and away went the balloon. When the man had reached an altitude which he thought was sufficient, he reached upward to pull a string. This string was used for opening a small aperture through which some of the smoke could escape from the bag. The balloon would then slowly descend. He pulled the string, but it broke off; and there he was with no means for getting the smoke out of the bag. There was nothing for him to do but keep sailing. It wasn't long before the fairgrounds were left far behind. The balloon still maintained its original altitude, but after an hour or so it gradually began to descend. Having no way of guiding the balloon, there was nothing the aviator could do about picking out a desirable landing place. All he could do was to hope and pray that he wouldn't get hurt in case the basket happened to crash into
