## AA Lists '12 Steps' Toward Recovery From Alcoholism

Cards announcing weekly meetings of the Waynesville chapter of Alcoholics Anonymous at 8 p.m. each Thursday at the Grace Episcopal Church parish house are now being distributed throughout this area.

On the back of the card is listed AA's "The Twelve Steps," towards recovery from alcoholism:

- 1—We admitted we were powerless over alcohol—that our lives had become unmanageable.
- 2—Came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could re-

- 3—Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him.
- 4—Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
- 5—Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
- 6—Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
- 7—Humbly asked Him to remove

- 8—Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.
- 9—Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
- 10—Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
- 11—Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscientious contact with God as we under-

stood Him praying only for the good of those who had done us wrong to care that out.

12—Having had a spiritual experience as the result of these steps, we tried to carry these principles in all our daily lives.

The card also lists the "12 Steps" in all caps: "God grant me the grace to accept the things I cannot change, the courage to change the things I can, and wisdom to know the difference."
