QUESTION: How many strawberry plants will I need for my home garden?

Answer: Approximately 100. The minimum number you'd need for commercial production is 1,500, which will plant a quarter-acre.

QUESTION: When should I set trawberries?

ANSWER: In Eastern North Carolina, from December of March; in he west, from March to April.

ANSWER: Yes, in those sections where the temperature seldom falls below 5 degrees. Early spring planting is generally satisfactory in all parts of the state. If you plant in the fall, wait until the leaves have fallen-last of November or early December.


