

District FFA Will Hold Rally In Asheville Soon

Nearly a thousand Future Farmers of American and vocational agriculture teachers from 25 Western North Carolina counties will assemble in Asheville on May 13th and 14th for a giant rally. This marks the first time such a district gathering of agricultural students has been held in North Carolina. In charge will be Howard T. Gryder, District Supervisor of Agricultural Education for the State Department of Public Instruction.

An outstanding feature of the rally will be a performance by a 40 piece brass band made up of members from as many high schools over Western North Carolina. Directing this band will be Charles Isley, band director of the Waynesville High School. On the same program with the band in the Asheville City Auditorium will be a 75 voice male chorus from the various schools, under the direction of Ned Hawks, agricultural teacher of the Sylva High School.

The future farmers, representing 95 high schools, will compete in various contests, including dairy judging, beef cattle judging, public speaking and parliamentary procedure contests. The winners of these events will compete in statewide contest finals in Raleigh this summer.

Winners of the various events will be honored at a luncheon at the City Auditorium on May 14th.

Assisting with the rally are John Nesbit, vocational agriculture teacher, Waynesville, and M. C. Nix, who holds the same position at Bethel.
