Ezekiel and The Earlier Captivity ILLUSTRATED SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

Scripture—II Kings 24:8-16; 25:27-30; Ezekiel 1:1-3; 2:1-6; 3:11-15; 11:14-20; 18:30-32.



In the reign of Jehoiachin, king of Judah, Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, besieged the city of Jerusalem. The king himself came to Jerusalem and Jehoiachin, his mother, his wives and all his princes went out to meet him. Nebuchadnezzar carried the king, his mother, the princes and all the able workmen to Babylon in captivity. He also carried away all the treasures of the house of Jehovah which Solomon had placed in the temple. After 37 years as prisoner, Evilmerodach (or Merodach), Nebuchadnezzar's successor, visited Jehoiachin in prison, and spoke kindly to him. He restored his rank, admitted him to the royal table, and gave him an allowance. Ezekiel had visions from God, telling him to go to his captive people and tell them that if they would keep His statutes, he would finally restore them to their homeland. MEMORY VERSE—Psalm 46:1.
