'Target Zero' Stars Conte As An Infantryman

Richard Conte stars in Warner Bros. "Target Zero," a new action thriller depicting the glory of the fighting G.I. The film arrives Wednesday at the Strand Theatre.

Conte plays an American infantry lieutenant, who, with his patrol becomes trapped deep in enemy lines. They are joined by a handful of British tankers who have also been by-passed by an all-out enemy attack.

"Target Zero" was filmed entirely on location at the Army's Fort Carson, Colorado, under what is technically termed "simulated combat conditions". The Army, co-operating with the Warner Bros. studio, in one instance loaned 1,700 men for an important combat scene.

Peggie Castle stars opposite Conte in the film, with Charles Bronson, Chuck Connors and L. Q. Jones in other featured roles. David Weisbart produced for Warner Bros. and Harmon Jones directed.
