

Welcome To The Duplin-Wallace Fair

FIRST DUPLIN-WALLACE FAIR
OPENS NEXT TUESDAY, 10 A. M.

The first Duplin-Wallace Fair will open Tuesday at 10 A. M. in Wallace with one of America's most exhilarating carnivals among its featured attractions. Tuesday will be turned over to the school children of Duplin and Pender counties and everything possible has been done to secure them a delightful time. The managers of the fair had arranged a special program for them. Tuesday night is to be the Grand Opening Night with a special program arranged by the fair. The manager of the fair, W. B. Reynolds, Duplin

County Agent, and Dr. Charles Dandridge of the Pender County Jail have been invited to attend and make short talks. At this time free gifts will be distributed from the stage and all the free acts will be reviewed. Wednesday night will be Style Show Night in which 16 beautiful young ladies will demonstrate what they will be wearing, with the Wallace merchants supplying the models. Special prizes and free acts will be given them all. On Thursday night a local contest will be staged by the Baptist

Minister of Wallace in a public wedding. There will be a special setting for this event, a good chorus and music. The wedding house has already been leased, and all plans are completed for the wedding. It will begin at 8:30, and will be followed by special acts and distribution of gifts. On Friday night what promises to be one of the most elaborate features of the entire fair will be given, crowning of the Fair Queen. It will begin at 9 o'clock. Henry L. Stevens, Jr., of Warsaw, has been invited to officiate at the crowning of the queen. He will present the lucky young lady with a gold bracelet, inscribed with words befitting the occasion. Fair officials have expressed ap-

proval of the choice of Mr. Stevens for this ceremony, if he is available. They ask the people of the county to support their favorite for queen of the fair by procuring tickets from the merchants of Wallace. Jack O. Roberts, who staged the Strawberry Festival in Wallace two years ago, and who is managing director of the fair this year, says that the free acts program will be held by troupes in regular circus and vaudeville acts, featuring the Famous Flying Howards, Cupid, the 18 months old high-diving dog, the Gregory Bicycle Troupe, Upside Down Atwood, the man who walks in the air, and others. These acts will be given every afternoon and night during the fair, and everyone is invited to see them. On the midway will be found the new \$10.00 ride, the Octopus, just out this fall; hobby horses; giant Ferris wheel, the dangerous Merry Mixup; and chairplane.

Some of the shows are: "The Old Plantation," with what is claimed to be the South's best dancers and singers; Girl Review; What Is It? Big 10, in One Show; and many other attractions. In all about 30 concessions will operate. The portable, all-steel exhibit hall is ready and over 44 booths filled with exhibits are being prepared. The Agricultural department, fancy work department, and others will be filled to capacity. All exhibits are free and no entry fees are charged. The Fair Association has expressed hopes of having some of the best exhibits ever seen in North Carolina. Seven experts on Indian lore and culture are planning a dynamic Indian exhibit for the World's Fair of the West to be held in 1939 on Treasure Island in San Francisco Bay.
