

**LUMBERTON MARKET BREAKS RECORD FOR PAYMENTS TO FARMERS**

Lumberton, Aug. 27—  
Lumberton's tobacco market has broken all records for daily payments to farmers for their loads, with every daily average running above \$45 a hundred and a total of more than 15,000,000 pounds sold through last Friday. Auction

warehouse payments total nearly half a million dollars every sales day.  
High baskets are running up to \$54 a hundred, and many farmers are averaging \$46 and \$47 a hundred for their entire loads, according to Jasper C. Hutto, Supervisor of the Lumberton market.  
There are six guaranteed sales on the Lumberton market every day, with seven warehouses handling farmers' tobacco from over the Lumberton area. So far this season Lumberton has maintained

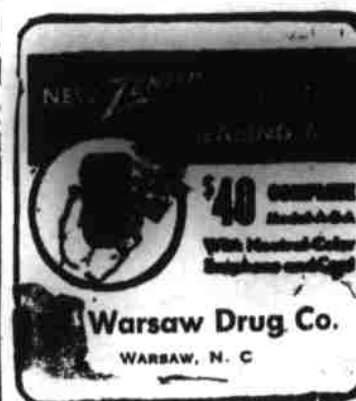
