Many lack experience in negotiating timber ales and making contracts or in finding markets for numerous forest products except through the local sawmill. Therefore, an uring timber of market size and urgent need exists for public assistance to farmers and other owners of small woodland acreages and to wood-using industry stock in a productive condition. in developing a systematic program of harvesting and marketing farm timber which will provide a continuous yield of highquality forest products and a per manent forest industry. Under this project the work of a farm forester is:

1. To promote a systematic harvesting and marketing of farm timber to supply the timber needs for the postwar period.
