Nations Attacking Stock Diseases

The entire world will soon be benefiting from methods employed in North Carolina in curbing livestock diseases, it has been announced by Dr. William Moore of State Department of Agriculture.

He finds that the United Nations organizations has accepted the recommendations of its veterinary advisors for a world-wide program aimed at controlling livestock diseases in order to increase food production. Plans similar to those followed in this State in controlling Bang's disease and cattle tick will be used.

One step, will be the prompt use of vaccines, chemicals, and similar products. Vaccines have already been sent to East Africa and China, where cattle diseases are a serious problem.

Change Requested For Food Division

A move to permit the Food Division of the State Department of Agriculture to derive its appropriations from the General Fund was begun by Agriculture Commissioner D. S. Coltrane recently.

He explained that the work of this Division is not confined to agriculture, but serves all segments of the population in protecting the consumer against contaminated, sub-standard, and mislabeled foods and drinks.

Log Measure Adopted By Grange

The North Carolina Grange has requested the General Assembly to establish the International log rule "and no other" as the standard scale for measuring logs and timber in the State.
The decision followed a controversial hearing conducted by the Grange executive committee on whether the International rule or the Doyle rule, now used, is the fairer and more practicable method for determining the board feet of lumber.
The Grange claimed a 16-foot log 16 inches in diameter, measures only 28 board feet by the Doyle rule, compared to 64 board feet if measured by the International rule.
Use of the Doyle rule, as now practiced in the State, prevents the farmer from obtaining full value for his timber, the Grange contended.
