administered by the VA. Q. Do the premiums increase as the insured grows older?

Q. Are there any restrictions in Government insurance on the type of work I do? A. No

Q. For how long can I carry the World War II NSLI that I bought while in service?

A. NSLI is issued originally upon the 5-year level premium term plan, which was extended three years for all policies issued before Jan. 1, 1946. However, veterans have the privilege of conversion after one year from date of issue to permanent plans. The law provides that all level premium term policies shall terminate at the expiration of the term period unless exchanged for permanent policies on or before the expiration date If term insurance has been converted, it remains in effect as long as the premiums are paid.
