State College Hints To Homemakers

With onions so plentiful these days, a homemaker is likely to find herself keeping kitchen company often with these lively flavored vegetables. Whether you get the best of the onions or they get the best of you, is often a matter of knowing how to handle them. For peeling onions without tears, hold the onion under water while peeling. This also keeps the odor from penetrating the air.

Cutting onions with a sharp knife is easier than grating and often serves a similar purpose. To keep part of an unused onion

from drying, slit the skin and cut out the portion needed; then wrap the skin back over the left-over part. Keep a cut onion in a cool place, wrapped in waxed paper to keep the odor from other foods.
