State College Answers Farm Questions

Q. What are the advantages of using radiant heat for brooding chicks?

A. Radiant Heat is greater in efficiency in fuel consumption, labor, disease prevention. More chicks per man can be cared for, floor space is more fully utilized, larger bunches of chicks can be brooded together without crowding, litter remains drier, and less trouble is encountered when radiant heat is used.

Q. What is the average number of pigs per litter in North Carolina?

A. Statistics on file at the Extension Service show this figure to be 6.5 pigs per litter.

Farm And Home Week Aug. 25-29

Featuring demonstration of all farm mechanization and labor saving devices, the fortieth annual Farm and Home Week will be held on the State College Campus August 25 to 29. It was announced this week by Director I. O. Schaub of the State College Extension Service.

With "Information, Inspiration, and Recreation" as the by-words, this year's event will combine two-hour lecture and discussion periods each morning with demonstrations, tours, and inspection of exhibits in the afternoon.

Suggesting that farmers and homemakers bring their problems along with them, Dr. Schaub emphasized the fact that "one simple problem solved may be worth hundreds of dollars" to an individual.

CARE FOR EWES NOW

VETERINARIAN SAYS

Pointing out that pregnancy disease in sheep is fatal in nine out of ten cases, Dr. C. D. Grinnells, veterinarian for the N. C. Experiment Station, suggests that sheep men give extra attention to the care and feeding of ewes in the next few weeks.

As lambing time nears, watch closely for signs of pregnancy disease. Symptoms include grinding of teeth, dullness, weakness, and finally complete collapse.

If a suspected case occurs, obtain a veterinary diagnosis at once. In the early stages recovery can be aided by medicinal treatment. In recent research scientists have found that niacin and thiamin appear to be helpful.

4-H Club Receives Cork Oak Acorns.

In a project designed to help make the United States independent in its supply of cork, eighty pounds of cork oak acorns were recently distributed to boys' 4-H clubs in Franklin County. The acorns, supplied by the Crown Cork and Seal Company of Baltimore,
