The Army has advanced anothe inducement to Veterans of World War II to join the Enlisted Reserve Corps by opening the doors of Of-ficer Candidate Schools to enlisted men of the Reserve Corps.

The new directive states that members of the Enlisted Reserve Corps who attend and graduate from Officer Candidate Schools will be commissioned as Second Lieutenants in the Officer's Re-

Lieutenants in the Officer's Re-serve Corps. They will not be re-quired to serve on active duty with the Regular Army, but may apply for such duty if they wish.

ERC graduates of Officer Candi-date Schools will be required to serve a three year period with the Officer Reserve Corps. This period will be waived however, if the man applies and is accepted for a tour of active duty with the Regu-lar Army.
