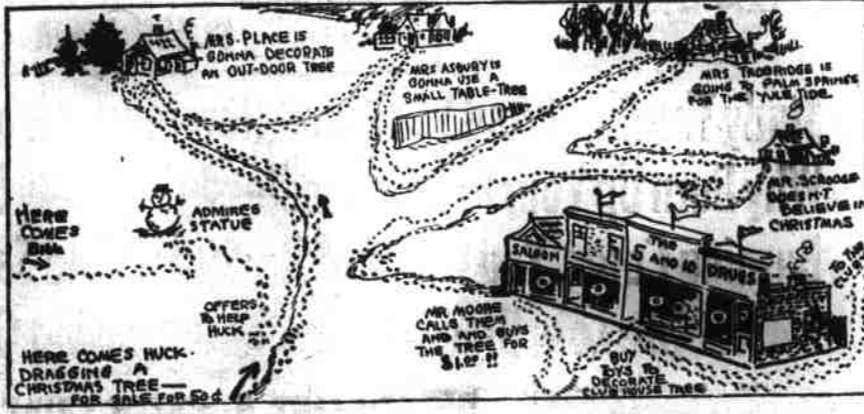

### State College Answers Farm Questions

Q. How can chick coccidiosis be prevented?

A. Avoid overcrowding; keep the brooder house dry. Add fresh litter often or clean the house often. Provide plenty of ventilation, keep everything sanitary. Keep visitors out of the houses and do not visit poultry dressing plants or other poultry raisers without changing shoes before entering your brooder houses. Clean and disinfect coops before bringing them on your premises. Do not use second hand feed bags.

Q. What can I do to control the tobacco flea beetle?

A. A dust mixture containing 1% rotenone applied at the rate of 1/2 pound to each 100 square yards of bed is recommended.  
Cryolite can be used at the rate of 1 pound to each 100 square yards

### Plenty Meat Is Outlook

Production of meat will probably be greater this year than last, but all the increase will be beef and veal. Meat supplies per person are expected to be greater during the remainder of 1947 than in the same period of 1946.

Hog prices usually increase from July through September, but may not during that period this year. Cattle prices are likely to decline by early fall when marketings of grass-fed cattle reach a seasonal peak.
