AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING \$25,000 MUNICIPAL BUILDING BONDS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Warsaw:

Section 1. That the Town of Warsaw issue its bonds, pursuant to The Municipal Finance Act, 19-21, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$25,000 for the purpose of erecting and equipping a municipal building upon land now owned by the Town, which building will be used as a Town Hall and to house the Town jail.

Section 2. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of said bonds shall be annually levied and collected.

Section 3. That a statement of the debt of the Town has been filed with the clerk and is open to public inspection.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect when approved by the voters of the Town at an election as provided by law.

The foregoing Ordinance was passed on the 2nd day of September, 1947, and was first published on the 5th day of September, 1947. Any action or proceeding questioning the validity of said Ordinance must be commenced within thirty days after its first publication.

NOTICE OF SPECIAL BOND ELECTION AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGISTRATION IN THE TOWN OF WARSAW, NORTH CAROLINA

A special bond election will be held between 6:30 A. M. and 6:30 P. M., Eastern Standard Time, on Tuesday, October 7, 1947, at which there will be submitted to the qualified voters of the Town of Warsaw the following question:

Shall an ordinance passed September 2, 1947, authorizing not exceeding \$25,000 bonds of the Town of Warsaw for erecting and equipping a municipal building upon land now owned by the Town, which building will be used as a Town Hall and to house the Town jail, and a tax for said bonds, be approved?

The question hereinabove set forth contains a statement of the purpose for which the bonds are authorized by the ordinance referred to in such question.

If said bonds are issued, a tax will be levied for the payment of the principal and interest thereon on all taxable property in the Town of Warsaw.

For said election the regular registration books for elections in said Town will be used, and such books will be open for the registration of voters, not theretofore registered, from 9 A. M. until sunset on each day except Sundays and holidays, beginning Saturday, September 13, 1947, and closing Saturday, September 27, 1947. On each Saturday during said period said books shall remain open at the polling place. Saturday, October 4, 1947 is Challenge Day.
