growers to receive the full value of their cotton crop. F. P. Johnson, Vice President of the Carolinas' Ginners Association urges them to request ginners to take samples from their cotton so they might take full advantage of free classing and grading provided through the Smith-Doxey Grading Service.

With over 100 different grades and staples of cotton, Johnson pointed out that "growers are not in a position to bargain for the fair market value of their cotton unless they know the grade and staple of each bale."

Every grower requesting this service will be furnished a small green card showing the official U. S. grade, staple and CCC loan value. A grower is then in a position to know whether the price offered him is below the government loan rate, and if so, to place his cotton under loan in an approved warehouse to await more favorable prices.

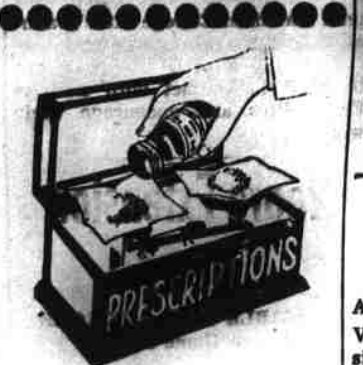
State College Hints To Homemakers

It's an old custom to pour milk on ink to remove it from textiles, but chemists advise other methods which are easier and more successful.

Writing inks differ so much in composition that no one remover suits all. What removes one kind of ink may set another. The washable, non-permanent inks, often used in schools, will come out by

rinsing in water and then soaking in soapsuds, but soap will set iron tannate inks. Prompt treatment while the ink is fresh and moist is most important, because some inks become darker and insoluble as they dry.

As soon as ink is spilled, spread cornmeal, cornstarch or talcum on the stain to absorb as much of the ink to keep from spreading. As the

powder shows color, shake it off and shake on fresh until no more ink is taken up. Then, pour on glycerine or one of the soapless shampoos on the fresh stain. Rub lightly between the hands, rinse and apply more as long as any ink comes from the stain. Finally, rinse in clear water.
