Judge Stevens Appoints New Court Reporter

Mrs. Vera Andrews of Kinston, popular court reporter for the Judicial District since 1936 resigned the position last Sunday. Mrs. Andrews gave as her reason poor health. The work, she said is getting too strenuous.

Judge Henry L. Stevens of Warsaw, resident Judge of the District announced he has appointed Stephen S. Worth of Fayetteville, stenotypist, as the official reporter and his secretary, Miss Lela Johnson as his assistant.

This will be the first time this district has had a stenotypist reporter. Mrs. Andrews used the conventional short hand system. The stenotypist has a small machine, not as large as a typewriter that types short hand.

Mrs. Andrews has been coming to Kenansville for 15 years or more and has many friends here. Prior to her appointment as court reporter by Judge Grady, Miss Gussie Edwards of Goldsboro did most of the reporting here.

Judge Stevens says Mr. Worth is outstanding as a reporter and the district is fortunate in securing his services.
