ing. The reduced corn crop will be largely responsible for the smaller supply, although oats and grain sorghum crops are also low. The latest calculations show that 112,000,000 tons of concentrate feeds will be needed at the estimated rates of feeding. This compares with an available supply of 107,500,000 tons after allowing for a practical carryover of 10,000,000 tons of feed grains into the next feeding year. Additional requirements will total 868,000 tons of alfalfa meal and 532,000 tons of bone meal.

The total need for grain concentrates and meal feed is 102,230,000 tons. Available for feed are 97,090,000 tons, leaving a deficit of 5,140,000 tons.

The need for protein feeds is 11,131,000 tons, with 10,499,000 tons available. That leaves a deficit of 632,000 tons.

The Bureau of Agricultural Economics estimates that if livestock are sent to market light, we will about skin 5y. But here is the danger. We will get by only through using supplies right down to the last kernel. What if we have another short corn crop next year, and maybe a bad feed crop too? Then the United States would go on short rations with the rest of the world.

Total farm production of food this year will be about one-third higher than before the war, but

our people are eating one-sixth more than before the war.
