

**College Hints  
To Homemakers**

Homemakers know their facts they can be confident of buying exactly the right sheets to meet their particular needs.

Some facts you should know are: thread count - number of warp and weft threads to the square inch - the more threads, the finer and smoother the sheet.

Muslin is best for hard wear. Percale is lighter in weight than muslin.

"Torn size" is the size of sheet before hemming. The completed sheet will be about 10 inches less than the torn size. Never buy anything shorter than a 99-inch length

for a full length bed.  
Sizes for twin bed (39 inch width) - sheet 72X108 inches; double bed (54 inches wide) - sheet 90X108; single bed or cot - 63X108.

When buying pillow cases, a good rule is to buy a case that is two inches wider than the measurement around the pillow, and long enough to fall a few inches below the end.

**Chevrolet Trucks  
On The Road**

Chevrolet sold a record-breaking total of 29,461 trucks during the month of October, 1947, which is the most that has been reported in any single previous month in Chevrolet's 35-year history.

Production and sales have been climbing steadily since the new "advance-design" line of trucks was first announced to the public last June. The previous record-breaking month for truck sales was June 1941, when 28,367 commercial units were sold.
