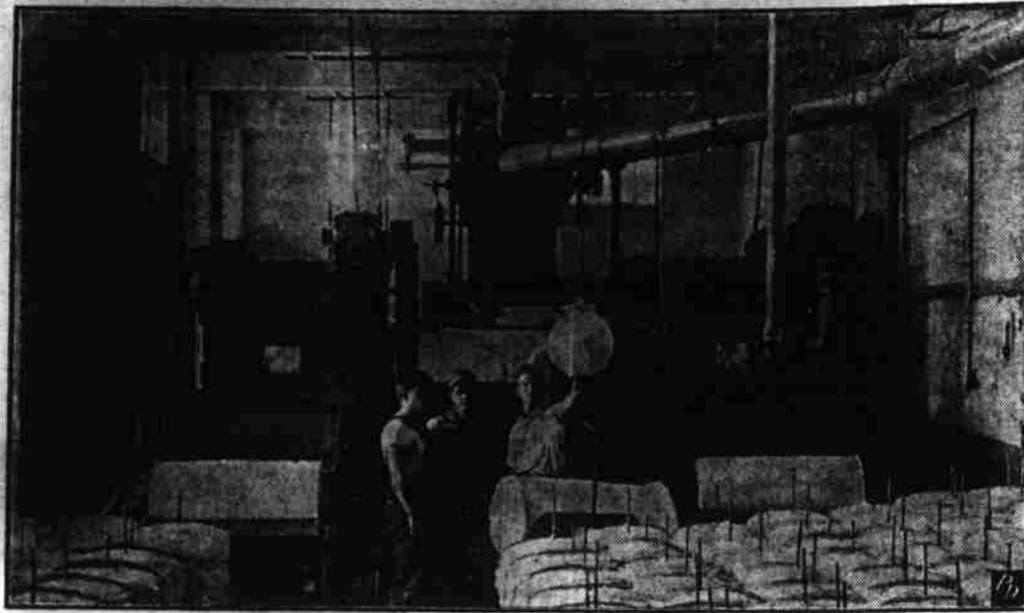

Modern Picker Machines



Employees of a North Carolina textile plant examine new equipment which is the "last word" in single process picker machines. Replacement of over-age machinery, buildings and equipment calls for the cotton textile industry to spend about one billion dollars during the next five years. Of this sum about one-half must come from profits because depreciation reserves were based on original costs which have doubled, according to estimates of the Textile Information Service.
