An employe of a modern New England textile mill is shown operating a new application of the photo-electric cell, popularly known as the electric eye. The device keeps the lengthwise and crosswise yarns in the fabric at right angles as it passes through the weft-straightenor en route from bleaching bins to dryer. As a result of this invention, miles of fabric now pass through the mill's bleaching-drying system daily, at the rate of 100 yards a minute, with a minimum of "seconds" or other loss due to distorted yarn in the cloth.
