**Dairying Is New Opportunity For Us**

A milk deficiency in eastern N. C. offers farmers of this area an opportunity to turn to dairying as a means of offsetting a likely loss of tobacco income is the opinion of Agriculture Commissioner D. S. Coltrane.

The eastern part of the state produces only about half enough milk to meet local demands.

Mr. Coltrane said "We must find something to replace some of the income which we are going to lose from reduced tobacco acreage. As I see it, dairying is one of the best substitutes. We have a good market now and the future offers even a greater potential market, for our consumption of milk is below the national average."

He said the Coastal Plain test farm had demonstrated that permanent pastures and good feed crops, the foundation of a sound

dairying industry, could be grown under eastern Carolina conditions.
