

Beauty Contests At Atlantic Beach

The subject for the contest is, "Farming - A Challenge To All". Virginia Hall, 17-year old student of King High School in Stokes County will represent the Central District in the State Finals. Laura Frances Pope, 16-year old student of Coats High School in Harnett County will represent the Southern District.

Ellen Dupree, 18-year old student of Smithfield High School will represent the Eastern District.

The fourth and final contestant in the finals is Francis Pressly of Scotts High School in Iredell County. Francis is the only boy in the finals and won the berth by a victory in the Western District.

The State Finals will be held at the Woman's Club in Raleigh following a luncheon. Guests will include many of the State's agriculture and educational leaders and officers of the two sponsoring organizations.
