pointed out that the law shows a special consideration for children and their mothers. Children under 18 and widows with children under 18 in their care are eligible for monthly benefits even when the deceased worker was employed in covered jobs only about half the last three years of his life. No benefits are paid automatically. When a wage earner dies, it is important for his family to file a claim at the nearest Social Security office. Monthly benefits are retroactive for only three months. Thus, if a claim is filed in the fourth month in which the wage earner dies, the month's benefits are lost.

Social Security For Widows, Orphans

Figures recently released by the Social Security Administration disclose that the average payment to a widow with two children is about \$48.70 a month; to a widow with three or more children, \$51.80. It was explained that these figures are not flat amounts, but represent average payments. It was
