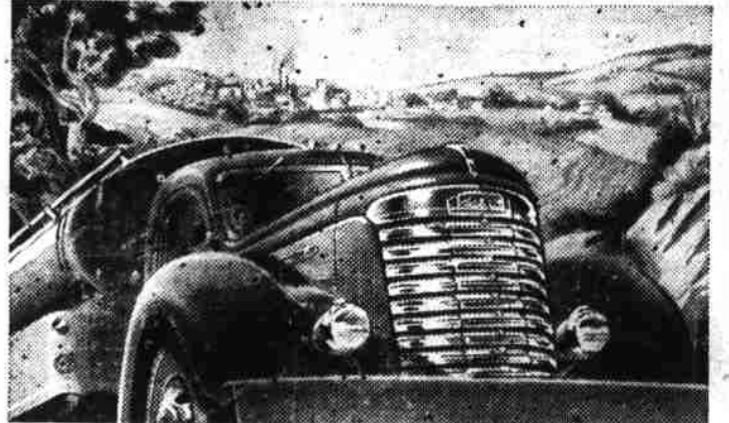
**D. H. Newkirk Buried Last Week**
