Southern Farm Market Summary

Short Thanksgiving week saw fewer hogs moving to market and prices went 50 c to \$1 higher than a week earlier. Meanwhile both butchers and sows moved \$1 to 1.25 higher in Chicago.

Southern cattle markets reported strong undertones with many price advances in evidence.

Thanksgiving trading was relatively light in major broiler areas since much of the holiday buying had been completed the previous week. Cotton prices changed but little during the week, and Mid-ling 15-16 inch staple averaging 31.62. This compared with 31.63 on the previous Friday and 35.92 cents on the corresponding Friday a year ago.

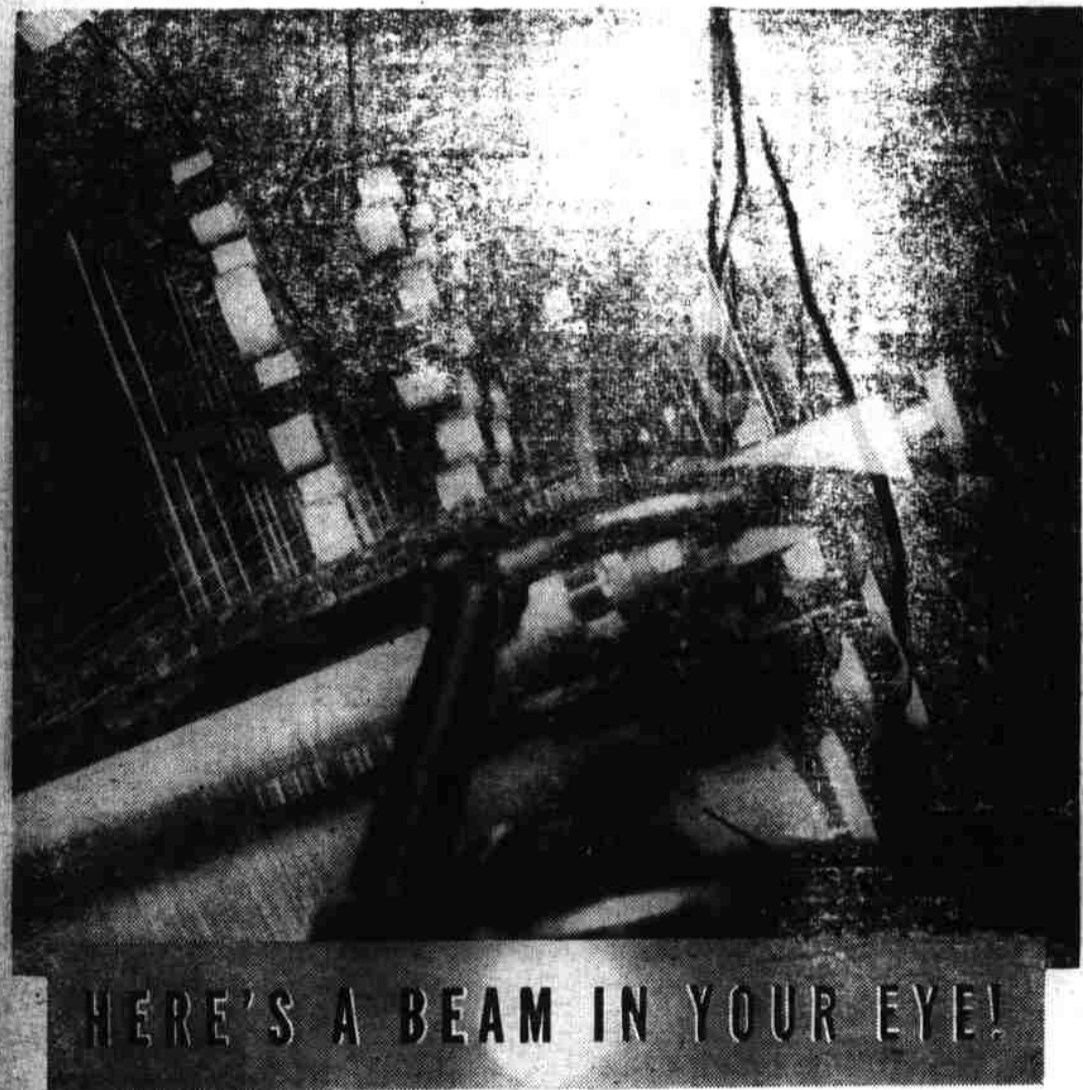
