## LOCAL LEGISLATION Issue By Institute of Government

The House Roads Committee approved the 1c gas tax increase this week, and it was sent to Finance where the \$200 million bond issue spent the week.

The present motor vehicle inspection program is dead, as the Senate on Friday passed the House bill repealing the present law. The idea of inspection is not dead, however, as a proposal for an annual inspection still rests with a House Roads

sub-committee, and a completely new program was contained in a Senate bill introduced on Thursday. The latter also provides for an annual inspection and requires the establishment of at least one permanent inspection lane in each county.

Changes in the Employment Security Law are embodied in SB 155. The minimum benefits would be increased from \$4 to \$6 a week and the maximum from \$20 to \$25 per week. With this increase in benefits would come an extension of time during which payments might be drawn from 16 to 20 weeks. Employers get a break too, in that contribution rates are reduced for all the rate levels except the highest.

HB 371 - Introduced by Outlaw, Feb. 15 (Calypso taxing power) Feb. 24, reported favorably by House committee; Feb. 25, passed 2nd reading in the House.

HB 486 - Introduced by Outlaw, Feb. 24 "To authorize the Board of Education of Duplin County to enter into construction contracts without complying with the provisions of G. S. 143, Article 8." (Provides that the board of education need not advertise for bids, receive competitive bids, or follow

other requirements of Art. 8, G. S. Ch. 143 in entering into construction contracts. Requires that all construction contracts be with licensed contractors and be for not more than \$100,000.) To Education.

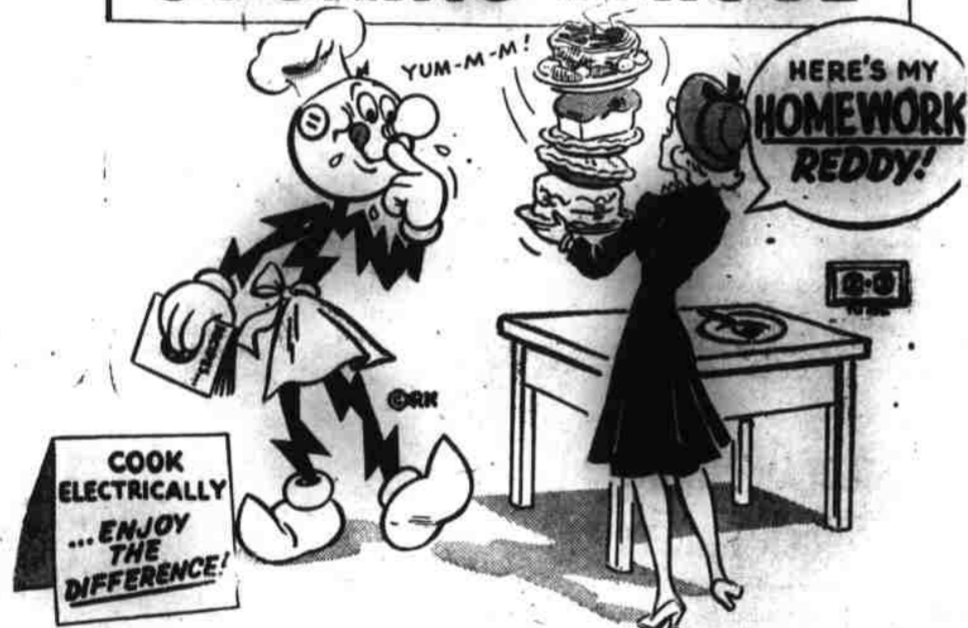

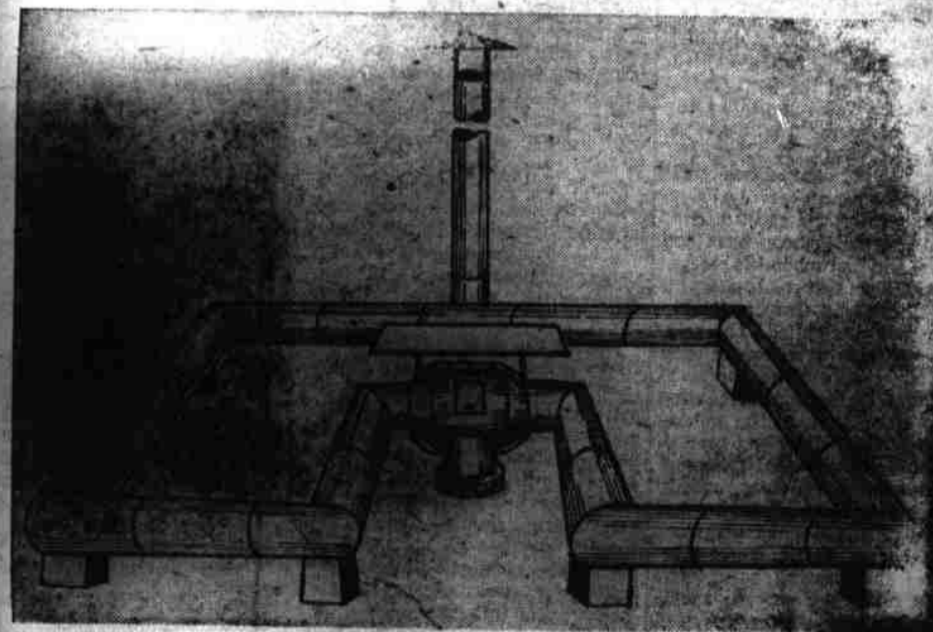
