A Dairy Field Day has been planned at the Coastal Plain Test Farm near Willard, for Thursday, April 21. The purpose of this meeting is to present to dairyman and agriculture workers of this area some of the more practical results of research studies at the Station. Special emphasis will be given pastures, forage crops and dairy cattle breeding program. This is a special day for those interested in dairying. The program has been planned jointly by North Carolina State College, North Carolina Extension Service and Experiment Station in cooperation with North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Bureau of Dairy Industry. This is a splendid opportunity for dairyman and anyone interested in pastures and forage crop improvement to gain the latest information available on these subjects. It is hoped that a large number of Duplin farmers will take advantage of this field day. The program will start at 9:45 A.M. at the Administration Building of the Experiment Station.
