## Conservation Farming

"I have found that my land is like my bank account, unless I put something in, then I can't get much out," said Mr. Hamp Grady of Kenansville.

James Ward of Rose Hill, told his Veteran's Class last week that every acre in Duplin should be planted to a soil improving winter cover crop by Oct. 15 if we want to get the most from our farms.

Lewis Outlaw said last winter as we were on the way to the State meeting of the Soil Conservation District Supervisors, "I have noticed that when we pass fields sown in cover crops they are usually around a nice looking and well kept home; if there are dead corn stalks and grass in the fields then the home is a little less prosperous looking, and if all the vegetation has been burned off, then instead of a home there is only an unpainted shack that passes for a home.

Roy Southerland of Rose Hill has planted his winter cover crops as set up in his district farm plan and by doing this he hopes to improve his soil some each year. With soil improvement will go bigger and better crops and with good crops and green fields then his attractive home will be even prettier and even more of an asset to his community.
