Drinkers Top Drivers Who Lose License

Raleigh, N. C. — Drunken driving headed the list of violations which resulted in revocation of suspension of driver's licenses for November, The N. C. Dept. of Motor Vehicles reported.

A total of 1,031 revocations and 317 suspensions were listed for November. 64 persons were convicted of drunken driving on second offense and six on third offense.

Driving after their licenses were revoked convicted 33 persons. 11 were found guilty of driving after their licenses were suspended. Aiding and abetting in drunken driving caused 7 to be convicted. 2 persons were convicted of hit and run, involving personal injury and 4 of hit and run, involving property damage. 30 were found guilty of two offenses of reckless driving.

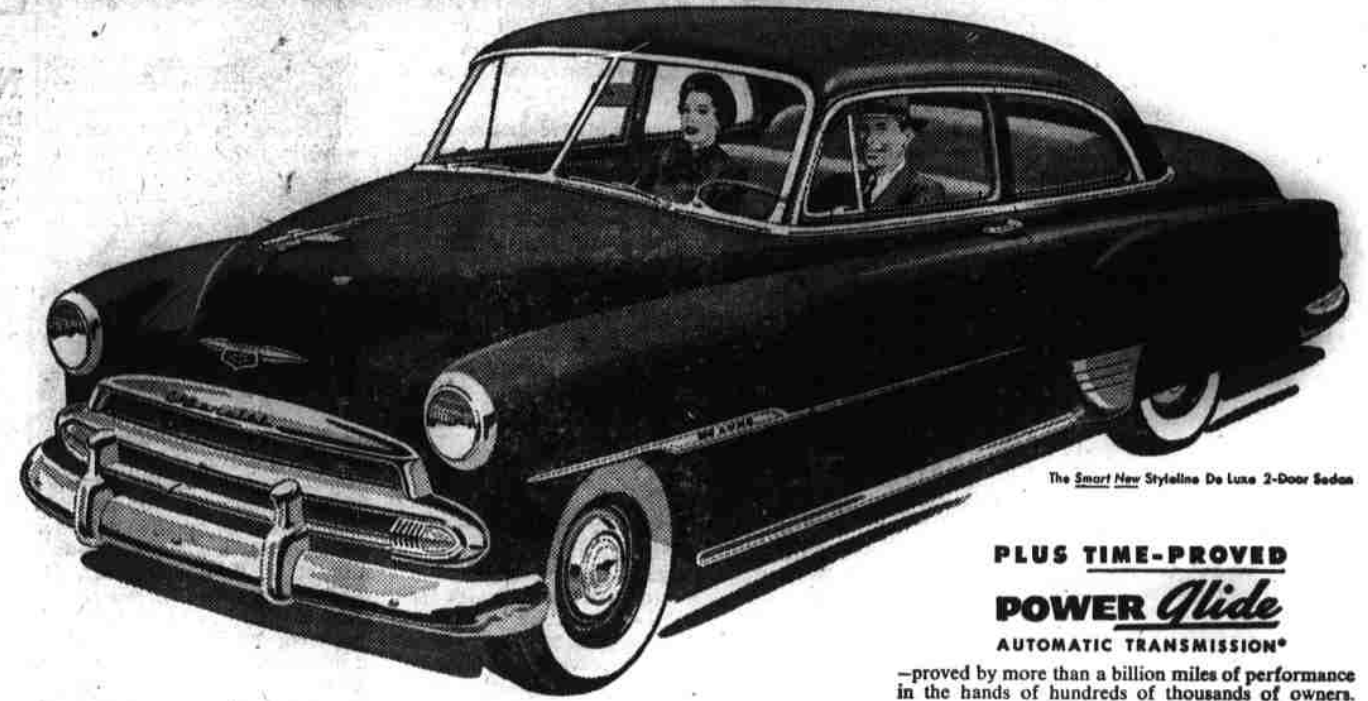
Also 7,069 persons were found guilty of violations which do not require revocations or suspension on first offense. Of the number 6,303 were North Carolinians and 786 out-of-state drivers.
