BANANA SPLIT - Nothing will delight the young folk more than a chance to make their favorite ice cream dish - Banana Split. For each serving use 1 ripe banana split in half lengthwise, topped with 3 scoops of ice cream, mar-malou topping, maple-blended syrup, chopped nuts and maraschino cherry. Heavenly stuff for the youngsters!

PEANUT SUNDA - An extraordinary super sundae can be had by topping butterscotch ice cream with maple-blended syrup, then sprinkling it
