

Dry sets are usually of the pungent domestic varieties and are commonly used for producing early green onlons or mature onlons for storage purposes. In buying onlon sets for the produc-tion of mature dry onlons do not select large sets but rather the small to medium s.ze. Sets that are over three-fourths of an inch in diameter will usually send up flower or seed stalks and will make a poor quality bulb. White sets are considered better for green onions because of the color, but yellow onions are better keep-ers as mature bulbs. For succes-ful storage onions must be kept
